

First look at Ubuntu Feisty Fawn Herd 1

I recently got Feisty Fawn Herd 1 (the first testing release) up and running in a Virtual Machine to take a look. While this is a testing distro does contain bugs, it's interesting to look at what's coming down the line for April of '07.

As with the previous several versions of Ubuntu, Feisty boots into a liveCD from which you can install. Note the familiar brown background in the image above.

The install went without a hitch into a virtual 10GB disk. As soon as the install completed and I logged into the desktop for the first time I noticed that there were 186 additional software updates to download.

Having done that I decided to have a look around.

As you can see there is a new kernel involved. Currently Feisty Herd 1 is running 2.6.19 with plans to move to 2.6.20 when it's available.
