"Frankly my dear, I don't give a damn" was named the top movie quote of all time by the American Film Institute Tuesday.

Clark Gable's memorable closing line from "Gone with the Wind" came out on top on "AFI's 100 Years ...100 Movie Quotes," the latest ranking of top movie moments that the organization conducts to celebrate the first 100 years of American film.

Marlon Brando's "I'm going to make him an offer he can't refuse," from the 1972 classic "The Godfather," was second, followed by another memorable Brando line -- "You don't understand. I coulda had class. I coulda been a contender. I could've been somebody, instead of a bum, which is what I am" -- from the 1954 drama "On the Waterfront."

Judy Garland's "Toto, I've got a feeling we're not in Kansas anymore," from 1939's "The Wizard of Oz," was fourth. Humphrey Bogart's "Here's looking at you, kid" from the 1945 drama "Casablanca" was fifth.
