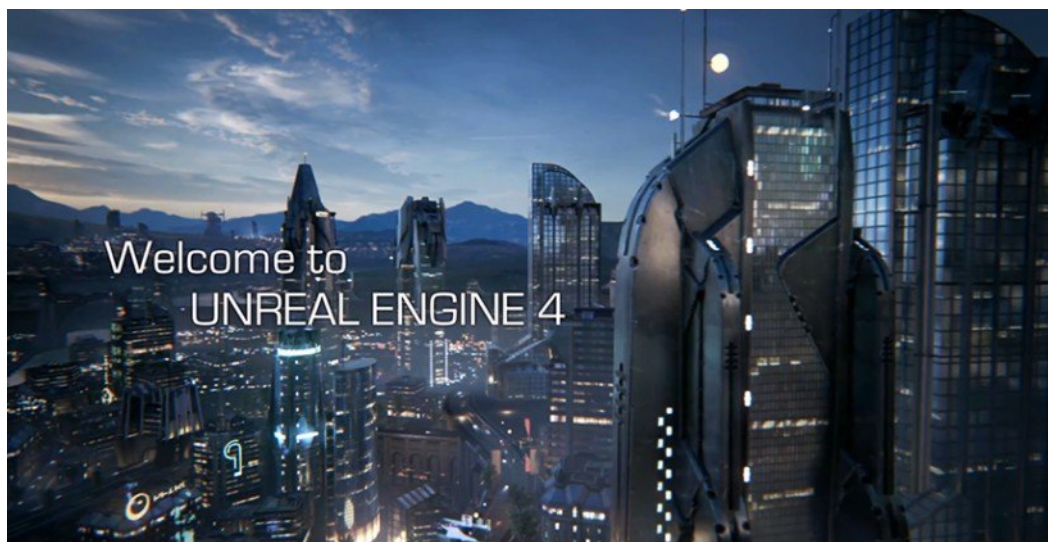


Linux Receives Its First Batch of Unreal Engine 4 Demos
