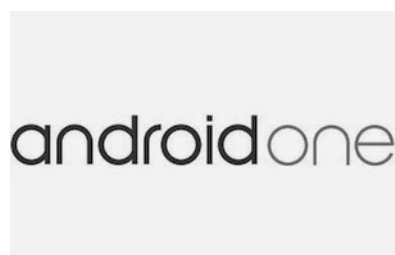


# Why the Android One Program is a Revolutionary Initiative for Developing Countries
