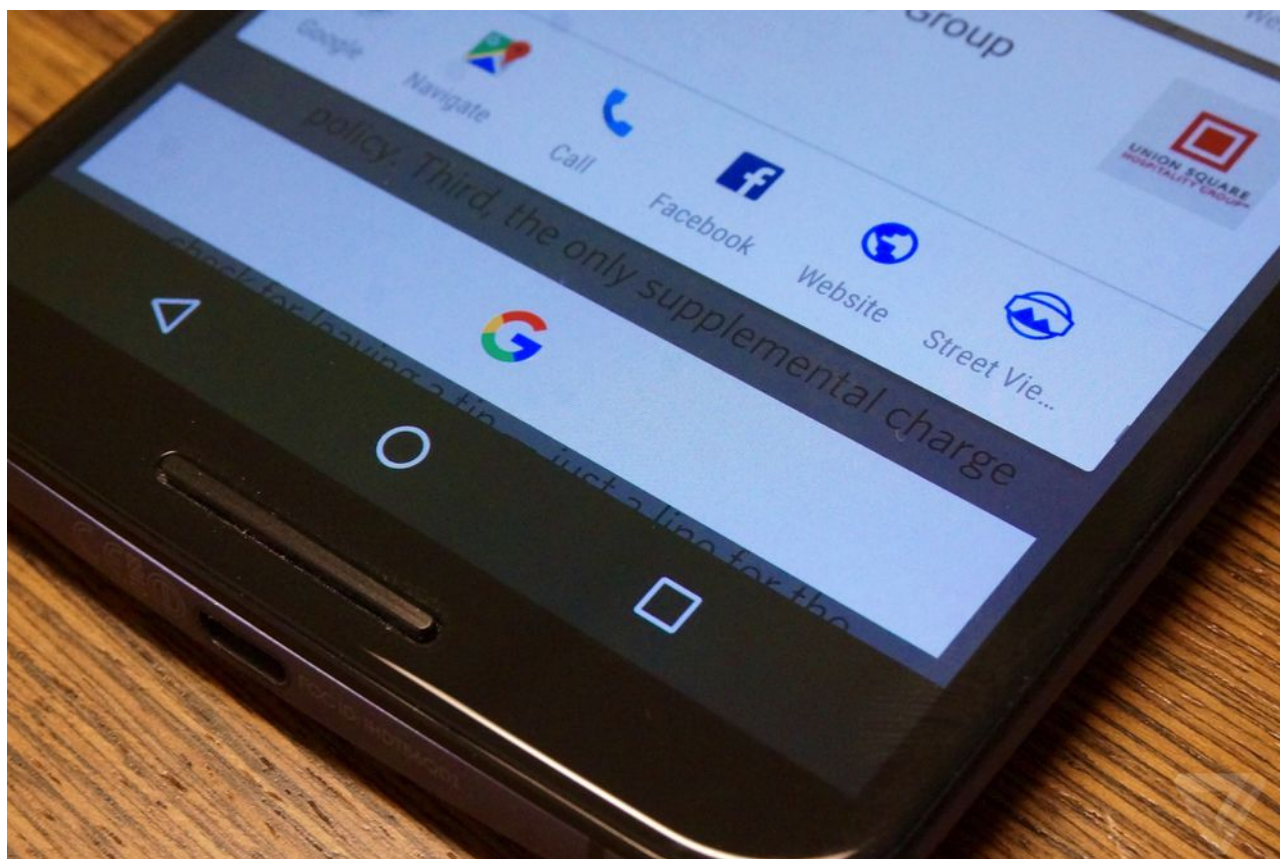


# Android 6.0 Marshmallow review
