There was even an interim-CRAN-only release 0.6.300.2.2 with a refinement for tests of incomplete LAPACK libraries---which we encounter whenever R is build with its own (partial) copy of LAPACK as on Windows, and on bigger computers whenever this was chosen over the default of system LAPACK.
