Fedora's leadership structure is a mix of appointed and elected positions, with many of the appointed ones selected by other project members active in a particular area. For example, on the top-level Fedora Council, we have two roles filled by general election, while the Engineering Lead is selected by FESCo (the Fedora Engineering Steering Committee) and the

Project Outreach Lead by FAmSCo (the Fedora Ambassador's Steering Committee). And, both FESCo and FAmSCo consist entirely of elected positions.
