Computer scientists have documented how a large and growing number of websites discriminate against people who browse them using Tor.

Tor is an anonymity service that is maintained with assistance from the US State Department and designed in part to allow victims of censorship in countries like China and Iran to surf the web. New research shows how corporations are discriminating against Tor users, in some cases partly because it's harder to classify anonymous users for the purpose of pushing ads at them.
